Patrician College of Arts and Science is a Christian minority, Self- financing, Co-educational institution affiliated to the University of Madras. It has worked its way up from a humble beginning with just 155 students in its inception in 2001, to become the No.1 renowned self financing institution in Tamilnadu and 27<sup>th</sup> among the best, Non autonomous colleges in India . The college has also been credited with 5 Star status by the Ministry of Education, for Innovation, and yet another milestone achievement of the college, is , it being reaccredited with the A+Grade ,with very high CGPA of 3.42 by NAAC, on 23rd Feb 2020.

The college functions in two shifts with 18 UG, 6 PG and 2 M Phil programs, with a total strength of 3509 students. This year 3 new PG programmes were introduced, M.A. Human Resource Management, M.Sc. Psychology and M.Sc. Mathematics.

Patrician College Empowerment Cell (PCEC) conducts the certificate and skill development courses . The Cell had organised courses on Skill Development ,Personality development and Empower yourself for a better career in association with IQAC.

## **IQAC**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell has been vibrant in planning and organizing quality initiatives for faculty and students based on the recommendations of NAAC for monitoring the quality parameters in the college in academic and administrative area. Several webinars were conducted for staff as well as students. Orientation for new recruits, internal audit for the entire college and feedback from students to check the effectiveness of online teaching was conducted on virtual platform.

AQAR and NIRF filing and application for ranking by INDIA TODAY and THE WEEK was submitted and most importantly the entire NAAC CYCLE II reaccreditation process all through the academic year was spearheaded by the IQAC team. The outcome of which was immensely gratifying to the Management, faculty, students and all our valuable stakeholders

### **ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES**

Every department has its own association through which it anchors its co - curricular and extracurricular activities. Despite the prevailing Pandemic lockdown situation, the Departments engaged the students and faculty by conducting Guest Lectures, Webinars, Workshops, FDP's, Inter Departmental and Intra Departmental skill building, Personality day and Career Guidance Programs and competitions through the virtual platform relevant to their respective disciplines. Renowned professionals and eminent scholars were invited as resource persons for the sessions.

## **SOURCE HUB**

The Placement Unit had a challenging environment this academic year. Despite all the challenges 110 students were selected by various industries. Online Training Programs and

Courses such as IBM P - Tech Course, "course on how to crack competitive exams" and on" job opportunities and employability skills post covid 19" was conducted to boost their morale, their attitude, personality and job skills. 135 students successfully completed and received ecertificates.

Extension activities provides a link between college and society. In order to mould students as socially responsible and sensitive citizens the college plans and executes its activities through the clubs and cells.

### **INNOVATION**

To promote Innovation and Entrepreneurship culture among the students the Patrician Institution Innovation Council registered with Ministry of Education Innovation Council in October 2019.
