A glimpse of his career testifies that he is an outstanding bureaucrat: He served as an Assistant Accountant General and Deputy Accountant General in the Office of the Principal Accountant General, Tamil Nadu, Chennai till June 2001; posted as Director of Audit for Public Sector Companies (ONGC and Air India) at Mumbai till 2004 and as Director (Personnel) in the Office of the CAG of India at New Delhi till 2006; served as the First Secretary in the High Commission of India at London from 2006 to 2008; worked as Senior Deputy Accountant General in the office of the Principal Accountant General, Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram till June 2010 and as Executive Director of Tea Board, South Zone under Ministry of Commerce, Govt of India from June 2010 to June 2015; functioned as the Accountant General of Odisha at Bhubaneswar from July 2015 to April 2018; served as the Director General of Commercial Audit in CAG's Department at Chennai having jurisdiction on Central Public Sector Undertakings and Central Autonomous Boards like shipping ports and commodity boards in south India; served as Principal Accountant General (Audit-1) Tamil Nadu, Chennai from 2nd August 2021 to November 2022.

His initiatives and commitment to public service was recognised by the CAG of India by posting him as First Secretary in the High Commission of India at London during 2006-08. As part of his official duty, he travelled to many European, South Africa, Sri Lanka, CIS & Middle east countries. As a graduate of Agriculture and Environmental Science, he is always interested in the profession of agriculture, public service, protection and conservation of environment.

We are proud to have such a guest with an illustrious career on this special occasion. Also, we thank you for accepting our invitation and honouring us with your presence.

Patrician College of Arts and Science is a Christian minority, self-financing, co-educational institution affiliated to the University of Madras. It has worked its way up from a humble beginning with just 155 students in its inception in 2001 to become No.1 renowned self-financing institutions in Tamil Nadu and 18th among the best non-autonomous colleges in India by Education World Survey, 2022. The college is awarded with the highest ranking of the year, 4 stars by Innovation cell, Ministry of Education, Government of India. It is a matter of pride that the college has been reaccredited A+ by NAAC REACCREDITATION with a very high grade of 3.42 on 23rd of February 2021.

The College functions in 2 shifts 11 UG, 4 PG and 2 M.Phil programmes in Shift-1, 6 UG and 2 PG programmes in Shift-2 with a total strength of 3,561 students and Ph. D.Commerce (Full and Part time). The college proposes to introduce 1 more section of B.Com General and B.Sc Data Science with Computer Science.

ADMISSION

1249 students were admitted in UG/PG and M.Phil programmes this academic year.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE: UNIVERSITY RESULTS

In the University End Semester Examinations conducted in April 2022, a total of **1109** Students (final year) appeared, and the overall pass percentage was 88.48%

MENTORING & COUNSELLING

To provide professional and personal support to the students Mentoring & Counseling services are offered under academic mentors and personal mentors. Designated hours are allocated to discuss academic and non academic matters.

SCHOLARSHIP/ FEE CONCESSION

The College facilitates the students with scholarships, fee concessions, private scholarships, and SC/ST, Central and State Government Scholarships. This year the Department of Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare offered scholarships to 544 students, the total amount estimated disbursed was 29,34,766/- .The management gives fee concessions and scholarships to students who cannot afford to pay the fees due to their financial circumstances or economic background. This year fee concession of Rs. 48,7869 and Bishop Daniel Scholarship to 51 students of a total Rs. 2,55,000 was given by the Management .
